LIMITED ENROLLMENT

This year's camp is limited to 30 students.

COST FREE!

Donations are welcome. Parents will pay a camping fee to Meadowgreen Appalachian Music Park and Campground: \$15 per night for primitive sites and \$45 per night for RV sites.

INSTRUCTION

Each student will receive three 2-hour small-group instrumental sessions and a 1 hour vocal workshop. There will also be plenty of time for informal jamming as well.

Students will learn three simple songs: an instrumental, a gospel tune, and a singing song. Our advanced students may showcase their skills with teacher and Music Director approval.

MEALS & ACTIVITIES

Farm to table meals are provided by our Chef Barbara and her staff. This year Saturday night will be potluck with camp providing the main dish. Snacks are provided during lessons through volunteer and parent donations.
